Consolidated Report of Additional Skill Acquisition Programme.

[2016-17 to 2019-20]

Additional skill acquisition programme, an initiative of Govt. of Kerala under higher education department, to address the concern of the growing educated-unemployment rates of the State, where students get an opportunity to update their professional skills and knowledge, covering the gap related to the lack of specific skills determined by the “digital revolution”. ASAP has skilled more than 2.5 lakhs students. During the Covid-19 pandemic it also brought skill education to the digital frontier.

ASAP provides demand based industry-led and industry-curated higher-order skill courses online and through its skill development centres in colleges, schools and Community Skill Parks. The courses include Communicative English Trainer, artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning, Business Analytics, Foreign Languages, Artisanal Bakery, Organic Grower etc. It seeks to promote the inculcation of a culture of product innovation and a mind-set of problem-solving through student engagement initiatives like hackathons and gamification. ASAP assists students in making their dreams and aspirations a reality.

Course Structure:

An ASAP course conducted for first and second year UG students consists of 180 hours of Foundation course and a skill course (the duration of skill course vary according to the course). Foundation course includes 100 hours of Communicative English module and 80 hours of IT module.

Report of 2015-17 Batch

- Total number students in 2015-17 Batch is 26, out of which 25 successfully completed the course.

Report of 2016-18 Batch

- Total number students in 2016-18 Batch is 35, and all of them successfully completed the course.
- Organised a program as a part of Kerala Govt’s Harithakeralam project , namely, ‘come on, clean your campus’ on 8th Dec.2016. On that day the students and SDE (Skill Development Executive) planted some medicinal saplings to make a herbal garden.

Report of 2017-19 Batch

- Total Number of students in 2017-19 Batch is 26, out which 24 successfully completed the course with 80% attendance.
- As part of world youth skills day celebration 2nd year Asap students conducted a quiz competition for first year students on 16th July 2019, Dr.Arunlal Mokeri distributed the cash award to the winners and interacted with the students by pointing out the importance of skills in job market.
