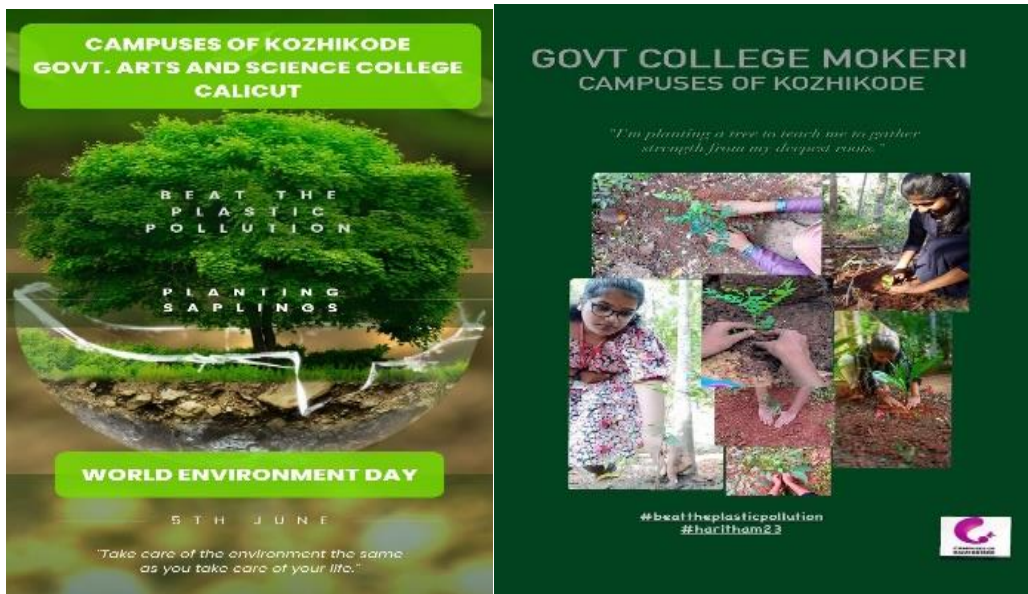
Meeting was convened at college and decisions pertaining to the proper organisation of the event were done. Purchase of saplings necessary for the day was also done.

Preparation Strategy

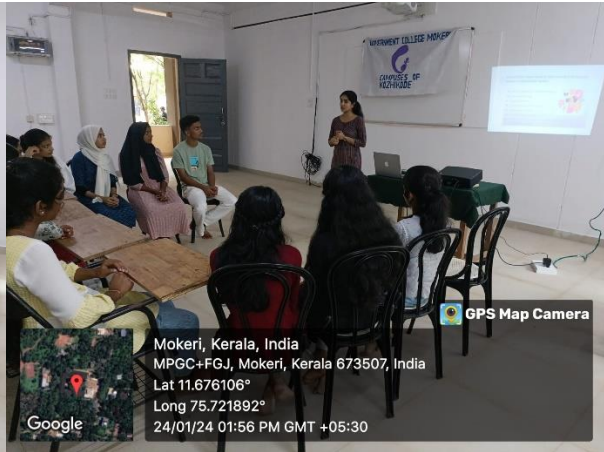

within themselves as they got into the vehicle for their return journey.

Activities conducted

- Volunteers paid a visit to the Thanal office at Purameri
- They spent half a day with the female inmates in there
- Access to the male inmates was blocked as two of them were infected with chicken pox
- The volunteers sang, danced and entertained the female inmates in all the three floors of their building
- Watermelons and oranges were purchased in plenty and handed over to the officials for circulating it among the inmates
- The fund collected from our food fest was handed over to the Thanal officials as a small token of love from our end
- Capturing photographs within the Thanal premises was prohibited as so those moments couldn't be made permanent in photos

Preparation Strategy

Consent was gathered from the Thanal officials as to when the visit could be made. It was ascertained that only grains, fruits and materials for cleaning purposes would be received from outsiders. Hence, after our discussions at college, it was decided that we would gift them with oranges and watermelons as per our capacity on our visit. Moreover, the unit decided to hand over the amount collected from the food fest as a monetary contribution from our end for their well being.

Outcome or Result of the Event

- The volunteers have said that the visit will always remain alive in their memories
- Volunteers have opined that such periodic visits to the place will be beneficial both for the mothers in there as well as for them too
- Getting to know the sad and disturbing conditions of the female inmates was indeed new knowledge for the volunteers
- 'Such visits are inevitable in the college curriculum as they allow us to stay grounded to the harsh realities of life', the volunteers said.

Consent was obtained from the speaker as to when the session could be fixed for. Meeting was convened at college and decisions pertaining to the proper organisation of the event were done.

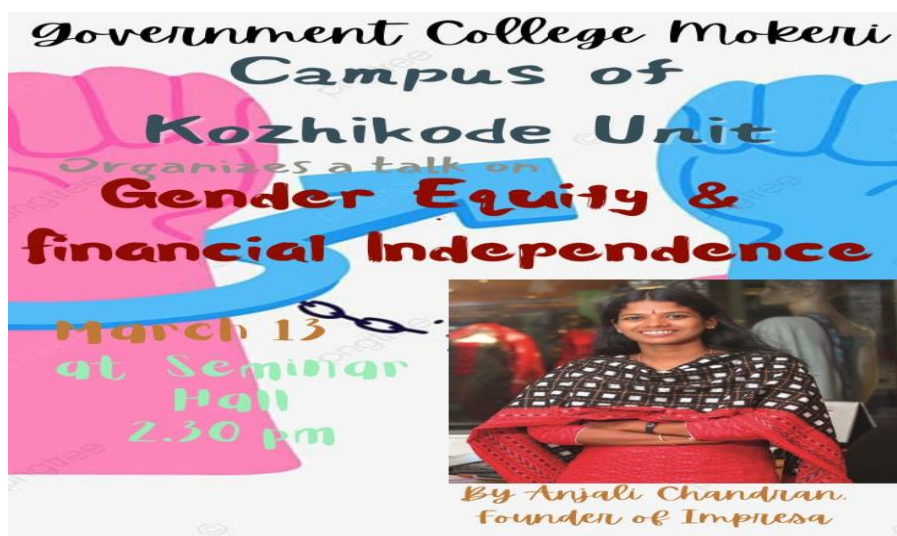
