Implementing student-centered approaches within the framework of participative learning and problem-solving methodology has effectively augmented student engagement in the institution.

Particular emphasis is placed on student-centric teaching approaches, which are evident in invited lectures, field trips and industrial visits. - Collaboration: Each department coordinates student activities with the aim of fostering a sense of teamwork.

- Debates: Numerous subjects incorporate debates, which force students to present differing viewpoints and thought processes
- Group work--faculty-led seminars and practicals are incorporated into all individual and group projects.
- Case studies -- Case study methodology is incorporated into the teaching and learning process in order to equip students with practical knowledge and logical reasoning skills that facilitate the development of problem-solving abilities.
- Analysis and Reasoning: Via internal evaluation and examines the application of analysis and reasoning are analysed.
- Wi-Fi in the campus encourages students to engage in independent study and discussion.
- Discussion: The institution incorporates discussion methods into the curriculum, as they encourage students to think critically and actively contribute their perspectives and recommendations in order to assess their existing knowledge.
