- Many of the subjects offered have topics which sensitize the students about the constitutional obligations.
- All students take a course on Environment studies as their Audit Course which gives them insight into environment acts, wildlife protection act, forest act, global environmental concerns etc.
- Seminars and workshops are conducted on days of national importance on various rights, duties and responsibilities of citizen by the NSS/Women's Cell and CoK
- Independence Day and Republic Day are celebrated every year to highlight struggle of freedom and importance of Indian constitution.
- Initiatives like conducting awareness campaigns, organizing orientation programmes, training programmes, seminars and workshops to sensitize the future citizens to inherit human values coping with the constitutional obligations.
- Flood relief activities undertaken by the NSS and CoK
- Sessions on mental health, knowing ones rights are arranged and engaged by the tutors/faculty at different points of time.
- College served as FLTC during Covid19. Committees formed with the faculty and the nonteaching staff monitored its functioning at the institutional level
- Promoting a secular perspective among the teaching-non teaching staff the college celebrates all major festivals.
- Ethical Values, rights, duties and responsibilities of citizens are some of the topics that are enlisted in Elocution/ Debates activities conducted in the institution.
- Legal awareness camps are conducted.
- Various departments of the institution and NSS unit are actively involved in conducting several activities for inculcating values for being responsible citizens— Blood Donation Camp, Anti Drug Campaign, Environment Day, Gender sensitization
