Report on Career Orientation Programme for 5th Semester UG Mathematics Students

A Career Orientation Programme was organized for the 5th semester UG Mathematics students of Govt. College Mokeri on 13th June 2023. 6. Soft Skills and Career Readiness:

Alongside technical knowledge, he stressed the importance of developing communication, problem-solving, and analytical skills to enhance employability in the competitive job market.

The session was highly interactive, with students actively participating by asking questions and receiving practical advice from Dr. Kayoom.
