Raising Deaf Awareness: Sign Up for Sign Language Rights

The session was organised in connection with the International Week of the Deaf (September 23-29). Preetha P.V, the co-ordinator of COK, welcomed the guests and talked about the accessibility barriers faced by the disability community. Mr. Abhilash M.S, a certified sign language trainer, led the session, while Miss. Fathima Fidha acted as the sign language interpreter. The event aimed at promoting sign language and the rights of deaf individuals among the members of the mainstream society and the need for the younger generation to grow up as compassionate and empathetic citizens. To bridge the communication gap between the hearing world and the deaf community, the resource person highlighted the importance of learning sign language and familiarised the students with Indian Sign Language (ISL) including letters and basic words. Students actively took part in the tasks they were assigned to. Ms. Miby Miriam Jacob, the disability club co-ordinator, delivered the vote of thanks. The session was an enlightening experience, and was attended by 45 students from various undergraduate programs.
